James . . . writes about how we are not to have respect of persons, or to show favoritism. . . . What was James trying to say? He was saying that if we have the faith of Jesus Christ our Lord, then we will be obedient to the teachings of Christ and not have respect of persons in our heart and life. Jesus taught that if we play the partiality game, then we are out of the will of God. As we study the teachings of Jesus and the apostles, they teach us that God is not concerned about whether you are rich or poor, man or woman, your racial status or your color. God looks at the heart, for His desire is that all should be saved. We, like Jesus, need to show the same spirit of love to everyone we meet. If we show love, genuine love, to those around us, then we show forth the spirit of Christ.

We can look down through history and see where favoritism and partiality plus prejudice have led to wars and to rioting. Because of skin color or ethnic background, many have been tortured, put into prison, or killed. . . . It has been said that more wars have been fought over religion than any other cause. Man's inhumanity towards man, one person's hate for another who does not meet his preconceived ideas, is beyond measure.

For example, when Hitler became head of the German government, he began to preach a doctrine of hate against other races. Every race of people was inferior to the German or Aryan people. . . . In the end, not counting the millions killed in bombings and fighting on the ground, he killed six million Jews in the death camps alone. No one knows how many other races died there. On top of the death camps, hundreds of thousands died in slave labor camps. This is what happens when you preach hate and prejudice.

Man is not naturally prejudiced. . . . How degrading man can be to his fellow man!
