Psalms 51:1-6, 10-13

1Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions.

2Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

3For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin *is* ever before me.

4Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done *this* evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, *and* be clear when thou judgest.

10Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.

11Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.

12Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me *with thy* free spirit.

13*Then* will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee.

This is a psalm of David, written when Nathan, the prophet, came unto him after the sin with Bathsheba and the murder of her husband Uriah. You can read that in II Samuel 12:1-15. David in his sin, repentance and restoration is a fore picture of Israel. For as he forsook the Lord and was guilty of adultery and murder, so Israel despised the Covenant, turned aside to idolatry (spiritual adultery), and ended with the murder the Messiah.

At What point did God Change?

1 Corinthians 6:9–10, Romans 1:18–32, Revelation 21:8, Galatians 5:19–21, Ephesians 5:3–7

I was talking to a person who has professed to being a child of God for many years. Then as they got older the things they believed about God changed. What they used to believe has changed. The shame is that a lot of the “Pentecostal” ministers have changed their preaching to reflect the changes that the world is putting forth.

Ask yourself: When did God change? His Word states that God is the same yesterday, today and forever.

If God stated in the Bible that something was wrong (a sin); when did He come back and change His mind? Can you find it in the Holy Word? Or do you find it in the modern translations? Or is it just the popular opinion of today’s world. Can you show me in the Bible where God changed sin into being OK?

We are the ones that God wants to change, not the other way around. When we, as children of God, change how we believe, and it does not line up to the Bible then we are walking away from God. If we start walking away from God, then we are leaving God behind.

There are several places in the Bible that list what will keep you out of heaven. Now the world and many Christians are trying to remove some of those sins from that list. What all of mankind should be doing is removing all of the items on those lists from our lives, our soul and our mind.

God wants us to become more and more like Him and less and less like the world that worships Satan.

The verification for our heavenly passport doesn’t depend on what *we* think. It comes in what the *Bible* has to say.

Galatians 5:24 says:

“And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.”

It’s that simple? Yes, exactly that simple. Now let’s see what this verse means.

Merriam-Webster says *passions* are intense, overpowering emotions. *If we’re not in control, we don’t belong to Christ.*

Then Merriam-Webster tells us *desires* are things that promise enjoyment or satisfaction. *If it’s material things that make us happy, we don’t belong to Christ.*

Ouch. That’s not so simple, not to live that way, anyway. *How can we make this change so that our heavenly passport is valid?*

1. Prayer.
2. Time in the Word.
3. A commitment to living a life that exemplifies the standards of Christ.

When it comes time, let’s make certain our heavenly passport is stamped by our salvation through Jesus’ blood.
