## The Roving Pulpit

From the book: A Study on Titus & Philemon

Titus 2:1

*But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:*

In verse one, Paul is giving Titus **more instructions concerning the Cretian church**. First and by far the most important thing to do was to **establish the Cretians in sound doctrine**. False teachers were bombarding the Cretian churches with their false doctrines. They were individuals that the Bible describes as blind leaders of the blind and having a form of godliness but denying the true power thereof. The Bible instructs us to turn away from such as these.

2 Timothy 3:1-5 *This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy. Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.*

The church of today, like the Cretian churches, is **constantly under attack from all sides**. The sooner that people realize that the **truth of God's Word is the only thing that can truly set us free**, the better their lives will become

Psalms 127:1 *Except the LORD build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the LORD keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain.*

Except God build the house, they that labor, labor in vain. **The Word of God is the only foundation that the church** can stand upon;

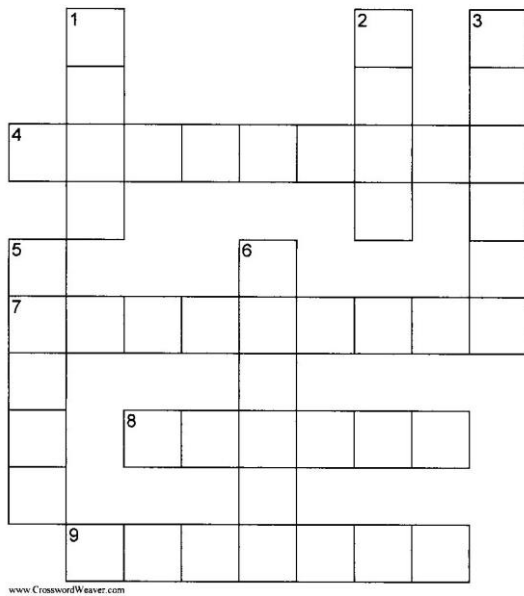
