The Roving Pulpit

God's Word – It Stands Written

A recent Barna poll shows 51% of pastors in the US don't possess a Biblical World View. What constitutes a "Biblical World View"? Belief in absolute moral truth as defined by Scripture. It is the acceptance of six core Biblical beliefs: 1) The accuracy of Biblical teaching, 2) the sinless nature of Jesus Christ, 3) the literal existence of Satan, 4) the Omnipotence and Omniscience of God, 5) that salvation is by grace alone and 6) a personal responsibility to evangelize.

Truth has lost her way in our culture today. Truth seems to be whatever the media, social network or news reports says it is--and many are buying into a pseudo truth. God's truth has been replaced by a counterfeit. The enemy of our souls is the mastermind behind this, and he originated doubt as to the validity of God's Word when he said to Eve in the garden, "Hath God said?" Through the centuries God's Word has been maligned, attacked, questioned, diminished and in some cases completely thrown out!

2 Timothy 3:16 (KJV), "All scripture is given by inspiration of God and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness." Theo Nuestos = God breathed, and man penned it. Matthew 24:35, "Heaven and Earth will pass away, but My words will never pass away." Matthew 5:18, "For truly I say to you, until Heaven and Earth pass away, not the smallest letter or stroke of a letter shall pass from the Law until all is accomplished." Revelation 22:18-19, "I testify to everyone who hears the words of prophecy of this book: if anyone add to them, God will add to him the plagues that are written in the book;
