## Thoughts on Haggai

Haggai 1:7 KJV “Thus saith the Lord of hosts; Consider your ways.”

The Complete Jewish Study Bible states: Here is what ADONAI-*Tzva* 'ot says: ‘Think about your life!’

If we think about what we are doing to and for God, would we change our life? God wants to be first in our lives and every so often we need to spend some time doing what the Lord told Haggai to tell Zerubbabel and Josedech.

We need to sit down and go over our priorities and make sure we have God in the #1 slot. If not, then we need to change things around until they meet the requirement that God has set before us in the Bible.

Exodus 20:3 KJV, *Thou shalt have no other gods before me.*

We, as human beings have a tendency to fixate on things that catch our attention. Sometimes to the point, if we are not careful, that thing starts to come before God. Then we have to remove it from the altar of our lives. It is even conceivable that we might have to completely remove it from our life.

I have known people who have made the statement: “I had to take everything concerning that one thing and remove it from my home.” It may sound harsh; however, it is better to not have it around and make it to Heaven. Then to even have it in our house and make the “pit of fire” or hell our eternal resting place.

I leave you with this: Consider your ways, think on your life, see if you can get closer to God.

## One More Night With the Frogs

Then Pharaoh called for Moses and Aaron, and said, Intreat the Lord, that he may take away the frogs from me, and from my people; and I will let the people go, that they may do sacrifice unto the Lord.. *And Moses said unto Pharaoh, Glory over me: when shall I intreat for thee, and for thy servants, and for thy people, to destroy the frogs from thee and thy houses, that they may remain in the river only? And he said, To morrow. And he said, Be it according to thy word: that thou mayest know that there is none like unto the Lord our God.* Exodus 8:8-10

We all say that we want what Esther had, “A night with the King.” However, so many of us settle with “One more night with the frogs.”

We go to church and spend just a few hours in God’s presence and for many, they expect it to last all week or longer. I wonder how close we could get to that person that God wants us to be after spending a whole night in God’s presence? Not just once – many times?

Yet so much of the time we fail to go to Our Provider when we need something, we fail to go to Our Leader when we do not know where to go next, and we fail to go to Our Healer when we are sick. This indicates to me that we are like that Pharaoh, and we want one more night with the frogs and sometimes we want a lifetime with the frogs.

How many times do we go around worrying about a problem? We talk to our family members, our friends, sometimes we may even talk to our Pastor about something that is bothering us, yet we never really take it to the Lord. We would rather talk/complain about it and half-heartedly say a quick prayer and expect God to do the work.

In other words, we are more like this Pharaoh than Esther. She wanted something from the King and went out of her way even to the point of fasting and stepping out in faith to get her answer. Yet so many of us would rather spend one more night with our problems, our sickness, our sins then to go to God in prayer.
