Paul speaks of being an athlete as an example of how Christians should live their lives. To be an athlete, a man or woman, boy or girl must learn that **to reach their goal they must train**, they must learn endurance. They must **prepare their bodies for the desired objective**. However, training their bodies is not enough. They must also **prepare their minds**. We can have a strong body, but if our minds are not prepared, then **we lack that determination that we must have to win**. Without that made-up mind, we will never be a winner.

The man or woman who has no self-control is subject to the whims of the devil. We have all seen or known of people who have no self-control. You can talk them into anything no matter how foolish. They seem to have no resistance to outside impulses or influence, and even less from inside ones. The world calls these people impulse buyers; the devil calls them easy prey. **To be temperate is to learn how to control how you react to outside and inside influences**. We must maintain mastery over all the wiles of Satan and our own selfish and evil appetites. It is like watching the television. Do you control it, or does the television control you?
