WITHIN THE IFGEA

The General Board meeting was held on February 12th and we welcomed three new ministers to our family, Rocky Blaylock from Texas, Louise Marrs from Oklahoma and C.I. Wilson from Texas.

With help from you, our IFGEA family we are planning on good beds in the men's dorms; like the ones in the women's dorm. They were donated to the IFGEA, however they will need to be unloaded and assembled when they arrive within the first two weeks of March. Call if you can come. I would give a date except that we will not know until after this goes to print.

Please pray about donating to the Building Fund. We are trying to have new sidewalks in before Camp Meeting and we only need \$1,050 for them and just to pay the plumber for the supplies and installing the plumbing will be \$10,000.00 plus the cost of lumber and furnishings for almost doubling the restroom facilities. Only through the help of you and God will we be able to complete both projects before Camp Meeting. Please pray and ask God what He wants you to do. Volunteers are needed for building and for cleaning the buildings the week before Camp Meeting.

There have been several occurrences where Ministerial Applications have come into the office right after a board meeting and been held over until the next meeting. Now policies are now in place so that when it happens again that they will not have so long to wait for an answer.

At this last General Board meeting, we has several names come up as being good candidates for Board Members. Please be

praying about this matter. The Board would like there to be six to eight members and right now we only have five counting our Assistant Superintendent so we need one to three more ministers. We can have male and female members so women please pray as well. Right now most of the people on the Board are from Texas and we would like to see members from the other states.

We have twenty-eight out of ninety-one credential members that are women and no women on the Board. God has given us women ministers and has given them the authority to do His work here on this earth. Have you prayed about being on the Board and just thought it was for men only? Remember Abigail, I Samuel 25:3 states "...she was a woman of good understanding..." and she used that understanding to further God's will.
