You Shall Receive Power

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you.... Acts 1:8 (KNJV)

But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: Acts 1:8 (KJV)

One definition of power is "the capacity or ability to direct or influence the behavior of others or the course of events." The power of the Holy Spirit spoken of in Acts 1:8 is translated "dunimas" from the Greek, meaning God's power and authority. Tongues of fire and the sound of a rushing mighty wind are symbolic of this dunimas power that clothed and saturated the 120 people gathered in the upper room on the Day of Pentecost. This Holy Ghost power used them to direct and influence the people gathered in Jerusalem that day. They were all aware that something miraculous and amazing was happening! This Holy Ghost power brought possibilities to humanity that had never before been possible through the infilling of God's Holy Spirit!

This same power, God's power, is available to us as believers in Jesus as we yield ourselves to Him, allowing the Holy Spirit to fill us so He can work in us and through us for God's purpose and His glory.

I pray you will make the choice to receive all the Holy Spirit has for you and be filled with His "dunamis" power!

Did you prepare for the Sermon?

Think back to the last sermon that you heard preached. What did you get out of it? Or, let me phrase it a little different; did you get anything from the last sermon you heard or preached?

If you are a minister and you know that you will be asked to preach. What do you do? You prepare for it. You pray about what you are to preach, you listen to God about it, then you preach it. If you are not a minister that is preaching the next service, what do you do? If you are like so many people, Christian and non-Christian, you just get ready and show up.

I was reading an article and it gave me room for thought. Daniel Darling wrote it called, “5 Questions to Ask When You Don’t Get Anything Out of Your Pastor’s Sermons” found at <https://factsandtrends.net/2019/09/18/5-questions-to-ask-when-you-dont-get-anything-out-of-your-pastors-sermons/?ecid=PDM189002&bid=1735033075>

The 1st question is “Have I prepared my soul for Sunday?” and that day should be any time we hear a sermon. A person putting in a flower bed prepares that area before planting the flowers. If they just walked outside, dug a hole and put the plant in, there is a big chance that flower will die. The same goes for the soul, if we go to church with a hard or preoccupied soul the seed that was planted will not grow. Therefore, we need to prepare our minds and souls to get something from that service.

It will take too long to go over each so I will list them here and ask each one of you to think about what you would have got out of that sermon if you had followed these points. You can even go to the article on the internet and read it.

- #2. Am I comparing the pastor to a podcast?
- #3. Am I Misunderstanding the purpose of Sunday?
- #4. Am I hoping the sermon hits others instead of me?
- #5. Am I seeking to be entertained rather than edified?

The Ides of March

As the story goes, Caesar was warned to beware of the “Ides of March” and it turns out that he died on that day. Now let us look at that from the Christian aspect. Jesus warned everyone that if they did not accept Him as their personal Saviour. Then live their life for Him they would spend eternity in torment or as modern man calls it – Hell. Just as Caesar did not pay attention to his warning, humanity in general has ignored Christ’s warning.

Will you do as Caesar and refuse to be warned? Accepting Jesus as our personal Saviour is not the only warning that Jesus gave us. Nor is Jesus the only one in the Bible that gives us warnings.
