### **Noise of War**

Exodus 32:17 And when Joshua heard the noise of the people as they shouted, he said unto Moses, there is a noise of war in the camp.

Joshua’s ears were not as aged as Moses’ ears when he heard the rejoicing and the worshiping of the golden calf. He confused it with a people that were engaged in a warfare!

Joshua was a man that loved God, not fully exercised in everything God had for him. He would later proclaim, “As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.” But at this point of his life he mistook the sound of false worship as warfare.

Just like today, there are a lot of Joshua’s that are mistaking the sounds of false worship as warfare. But God is calling them out.

Verse 18: And he said, it is not the voice of them that shout for mastery...

Moses said to Joshua. There is a noise, but it is not one that is out of a victorious heart. One that rises up to the very throne of God and moves heaven.
