Being Saturated in the Spirit

One of the most favorite subjects in my life is talking about walking in the Spirit, living in the Spirit. The Lord put this on my heart this past week and I want to share it with you all. Many a person, including myself, at one time or another has asked the question: How did you get there? Meaning, how did you get the glory you have on your life? It is not a set formula for one to use nor is it up to you as an individual just because you think you deserve it. It is up to God and your relationship to Him. How much God the Father can trust you with and how real you can be with Him. Yes, I said how much God the Father can trust you and you be real with Him. Just because you are a pastor, an evangelist, or an ordinary person, does not mean that you are anointed with the Glory of God the Father on your life.

There are a lot of fake people out there, that go through the motions and say they are filled and saturated with the presence of God, but in reality they could not even muster a hoot from God the Father. The cost is high, and that is why a lot of people don't want to pay the price that God the Father has, so we try to imitate what is so real and tangible of the things of God, that we make a mockery of the things of God the Father. It may cost you everything: family, friends, things, popularity and reputation. What price are you willing to pay? What are you willing to give up of yourself to have the Glory of God the Father on your life?
